HISTORY

The team consisting Fr.Jebamalai Raja SJ, Fr.Eugine SJ, Fr.Sebastian Crossian SJ and Dr.Bernard D'Sami came together to explore the possibilities of working for migrant workers. Because of the research and analysis done on migrant workers by the team, they found that there are two types of migrant workers in Tamil Nadu:

1. Migrant workers within India (inter-state migrants) 2. Migrant workers across India (Overseas migrants). Fr. Eugine was the first founding director of Jesuit Migrants Ministry External (JMMEx).

Having explored and analyzed the challenges of migrant workers in foreign countries, the team felt the need to explore more by being in the rural villages, from where the migrant workers move to foreign countries. One of the main reasons for basing JMMEx in Thiruvannamalai district was that according to the Tamil Nadu Migration Survey of 2015 (TMS) the district of Thiruvannamalai has the highest number of undocumented migrant workers. Later on the fieldworks done in the villages of Thiruvannamalai, Cuddalore & Viluppuram districts brought in various needs of migrant workers. One of the main needs of migrant workers is to empower them with entrepreneurial skills. Fr. Eugine SJ as Director and Fr. Prabu SJ as Assistant director along with the staff led JMMEx from 2017-19. The identified migrant workers were gathered in villages for motivating them to be entrepreneurs.

The maiden Self-Help Group of migrant workers was started on 05 February 2019 with 15 members with a view to instill the habit of saving and guiding them to be entrepreneurs eventually. Later in 2019 Fr. Prabu SJ took over as the Director of JMMEx and Fr. Velankanni SJ joined him in mission. After analyzing the needs and requirements of migrant workers, the office for JMMEx was placed and developed in Kasthambadi. From 2021 Fr. Velankanni SJ as Director of JMMEx and Fr. Prabu SJ as Co-director with the efficient staff serve the migrant workers in various ways. JMMEx caters services to more than 350 families of migrant workers, spread out in 225 villages of the districts of Thiruvannamalai, Kallakurichi, Cuddalore and Viluppuram. A big thanks to all our staff and benefactors for their selfless services and commitment towards migrant workers.
