TEACHER ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

Teacher Enhancement Programs : Our school conducts Teacher Enhancement Programs aimed at honing the skills of educators in the classroom for the modern generations. Through these ongoing professional development opportunities, 27 teachers receive comprehensive training each year.

Soft Skills Training for Teachers: Workshops and training sessions are conducted to equip teachers with essential soft skills, such as communication and interpersonal skills, to foster effective teaching and learning environments.

VARIOUS NEEDS THAT HAS TO BE ADDRESSED TO EMPOWER THE SCHOOL

In spite of being Government Non-aided school, which poses a constant financial constraint, the school has consistently accompanied the students over the years. The only source of income is the 20% of Tuition fees collected from the students and, the balance 80% as scholarships, by the Province and a few dedicated donors. Operational and maintenance expenses absorb a substantial portion of resources, necessitating heavy dependence on the institution's initial investment to sustain both operations and infrastructure. Though we have managed with these limited resources there remains a gap for development that has to be addressed. We present to you some of the Infrastructural as well as supportive needs that we have identified.

1. SUPPORTIVE NEEDS

A. SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS

The inability of parents, predominantly from underprivileged backgrounds, to afford minimal admission fees poses a significant challenge. To address this, scholarships are imperative to ensure equitable access to education for deserving students.



90 € per student for a year (500 STUDENTS)
270 € per hosteller for a year (200 STUDENTS)

B. REMUNERATION FOR TEACHERS

The current teacher salaries fall significantly below the industry standards, posing challenges in attracting and retaining quality educators. Enhancing teacher salaries is crucial for maintaining instructional quality and retaining talent. Additionally, implementing Teacher Enhancement Programs to provide ongoing training for our educators is crucial. With the aid of scholarships, we can fulfill these essential needs and ensure the continuous improvement of our teaching staff.

3,450 € per teacher for a year (27 TEACHERS)

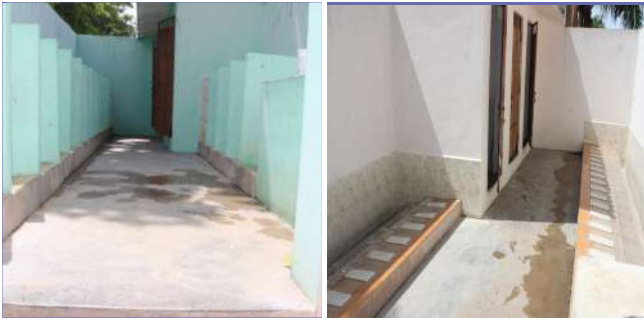

2. INFRASTRUCTURAL NEEDS

A. INADEQUATE SANITARY FACILITIES

There are more than 300 girls studying in the school, but the absence of proper sanitary facilities for girls presents a pressing concern, affecting the health and well-being of both students and teachers.



1,200 € per Toilet
(The standard ratio being 1 toilet : 15 Students.
Hence 20 toilets are required for 300 students)
24,000 € - 20 Toilets

B. NEED FOR SHED AND FLOORING

The absence of adequate shelter during the monsoon season, coupled with the accumulation of stagnant water near the Assembly Stage, hampers students' mobility and poses health risks due to potential mosquito breeding. If the need is addressed, it will help provide students with a conducive environment for various activities, including studying, dining, and assembly prayers.

18,000 € Shed and flooring



C. TEACHING AND LEARNING AIDS

There is a pressing need to develop the infrastructure of the schools like Renovating the Library, Equipping LRC, Enhancing Computer labs, Renovating and Painting damaged classrooms and Procuring Sports materials.



- **1,680 € per smart classroom**
(We propose 5 classrooms)
- **2,500 € - Library Renovation**
- **3,000 € - Installing a Learning and Resource Center (LRC)**
- **4,000 € - Maintaining the Computer lab**
(Renovating, Furniture, Software, Lab requirements)
- **2,500 € - Sports materials & Facilities**
- **20,000 € - Renovation and Painting works of Damaged classrooms**

Loyola Higher Secondary School

Loyola Higher Secondary School, Kuppayanallur was established in **1995** by the Jesuits, with a single mission to educate the poor Dalit students who were subjected to various societal, economic and political discriminations. This rural school is located in Kuppayanallur Village, Kanchipuram District, Tamil Nadu, India. This institution has emerged as a beacon of hope for the marginalized communities in Kanchipuram and Chengalpattu districts which were the epicentres of caste based oppression.

With over **700** students, the school operates as a Tamil medium institution without government aid, offering holistic education beyond the classroom. Noteworthy initiatives include providing scholarships to **85%** of students, fostering academic excellence with **18,000** students impacting the society positively, excelling in sports and cultural activities, offering diverse programs like anti-drug awareness and skill development, emphasizing Spoken English classes for better job prospects, promoting overall student growth with a **95%** pass rate, and conducting teacher enhancement programs to empower educators and enhance teaching quality.
